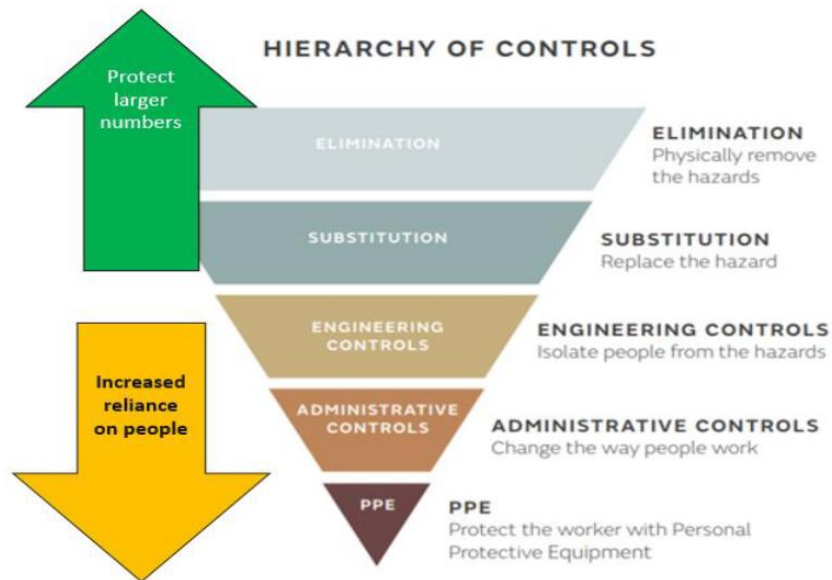

**HIERARCHY OF CONTROL, GUIDING OUR ACTIONS**



## Hierarchy of controls applied COVID-19



### SOCIAL DISTANCING



Regular and effective hand-washing, disinfection, “shield” vulnerable groups, avoid close contact between workers, maintain social distancing.

Social distancing achieved by process or facility changes or modifications to normal processes.

Perspex screens, revised seating arrangements in canteens and welfare areas for example....

Business communications, guidance e.g. increased use of Teams, shift timings etc..

Fluid Resistant Surgical Masks/Visors,(together with good hand hygiene and other measures) if 2m(6ft), Social Distancing not achieved

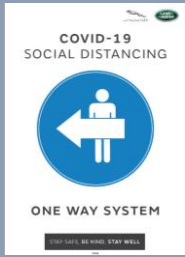
## CURRENT SITE CONDITIONS

### All employees and partners issued with visor or masks.



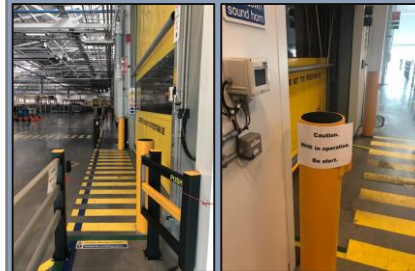
Hand Sanitiser provided with re-fill stations.

Urinals closed off to support social distancing

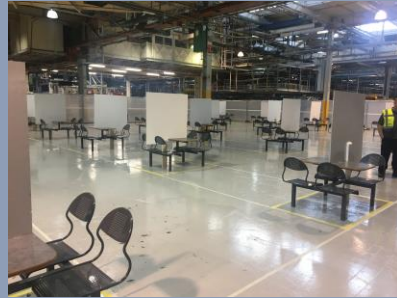


One person blue box
