Traineeships....







A traineeship is a funded skills development programme

- Access a Traineeship as a way of bringing a young person into your business through a trial period with no cost
- Progress the trainee onto an Apprenticeship for further funding and training
- Give the young person exposure to a real workplace so they can develop the skills, knowledge, confidence, attitudes, and behaviours they need to succeed at work.

Brokers will help you access the Traineeship scheme by talking to the most suitable providers for your business.









The Kickstart Scheme provides funding to employers to create jobs for 16 to 24 year olds on Universal Credit. Employers of all sizes can apply for:

- 100% of the National Minimum Wage or the National Living Wage
- 25 hours per week for a total of 6 months
- Associated employer National Insurance contributions
- Any relevant workplace pension contributions (automatic enrolment)

Further funding is available for training and support!

Adult Education Budget







- Local responsibility through Devolution of £53m innovation and flexibility
- Available from 19+ and to provide those in the LCR with the skills and learning they need to equip them for work, an apprenticeship or other learning.
- Fully funded for unemployed and lower paid. Subsidised for other eligible learners.
- All English and Maths provision up to and including Level 2 and basic IT training is fully funded for those that need them as are first Level 2.
 - First Level 3 skills for residents can in many cases be fully funded through AEB or the National Lifetime Guarantee.

Up to 70% funding

You can be self employed / sole trader or have a workforce of any size! You just need to be based in Liverpool City Region (Halton, Knowsley, Liverpool, Sefton, St Helens, Wirral) and not be Public Sector.

Be More can fund bespoke training packages, does not have to be an accredited programme or a qualification although we can also support this also.

Training programmes funded such as:

HR, Finance, Business Skills, Management, Health & Social Care, Hair & Beauty, Languages, Technical Training, Yoga Teacher Training.

> Be More cannot fund Mandatory or Statutory training or licences to practice.
