- Make and serve drinks as per customer orders
- Welcome customers and take orders for food and drinks, process the orders through the till point accurately and ensure correct payment is taken
- Follow the correct food safety, health and safety and lifting and handling guidelines
- Answer customer queries relating to the menu, the ingredients and recipes
- Maintain full knowledge of the ingredients used to ensure correct allergy information is relayed to the customer as required
- Deliver drinks and food orders to the customers
- Nurture friendly relationships with customers to increase loyalty and boost our reputation
- Clear and clean any used tables swiftly ready for the next customer
- Serve cake orders, ensuring the correct presentation
- Cleaning and restocking the cafe counter as required throughout the day
- Cleaning the cafe seating areas as required throughout the day, and ensuring a high standard of cleaning is completed at the end of every shift
- Process all used tableware and glassware through the dishwasher
- At the start and end of the day, setup the café tables / chairs / planters outside of the main door
