Requirement of Bubble.io application development resource specific to the development platform

Background

Decently are a Liverpool based digital health product company. Over the past 12 months we have been working with Mental Health NHS Trusts and Clinicians to explore building a digital solution (App) to help with the care for patients that have experienced a traumatic brain injury and as a result have challenging to manage behaviours that often result in hugely damaging violent and aggressive incidents.

We have created a working Figma prototype and have made the decision to progress to next stage via creation of the App through Bubble.io platform, we therefore now need a Bubble.io dev partner to help us build v1 for Pilot on wards in 2023.

Requirement

The Bubble.io App will need to capture behaviour data across adhoc observations, risk assessments and incident reporting against individual patients to inform summary dashboards and analytics to help clinicians make evidence based decisions about patient care.

More information will be shared upon receipt of EOI and completion of attached NDA but a brief overview of requirements for v1.0/Pilot is as follows;

- A mobile-first web application, it is likely this will be used on mobile, tablets and PC/Laptops
- potential for a high level of data, user and access controls
- Compliance with WCAG 2.1
- This product will ultimately handle multiple organisations with different levels of user access for different users
- Data will be stored inside England where possible, where data is not stored in England a risk assessment must be carried out and signed off by Decently.
- Third-party tooling, plugins and APIs used for development are logged and tracked with risk assessments for all plugins (this includes software libraries used for development purposes)
- Patient onboarding and information
- Patient incident reporting and logging
- Patient review and insights
- Admin and user management

Deliverable Timescale

- Target to go through iterative internal testing and live with v1.0 by March 2023

Indicative Budget

- £15-30k

Evaluation Criteria

Quotations will be assessed and scored on the following criteria:

Quality/ Technical Merit (50%)

Supplier must demonstrate they have the technical and professional capability to deliver the requirement.

Delivery Timescale (20%)

Supplier must demonstrate they can deliver the requirement to timescales above.

Cost/Value for money (30%)

Does supplier offer value for money. This will not necessarily be the cheapest quote.

Scoring Methodology

4 Excellent	Proposal meets and in some places, exceeds the required standard
3 Good	Proposal meets required standard
2 Acceptable	Proposal meets the required standard in most respects, but is lacking or inconsistent in others
1 Poor	Proposal falls short of expected standard
0 Unacceptable	Completely or significantly fails to meet required standard or does not provide the relevant answer
