









Request for Quotation Supply, installation and refurbishment of containers, and renovations to existing premises

Background

Barerooms offers its members a new way to exercise, we provide private spaces for exercise and recreation. Our rooms are fully equipped with access to online content enabling us to assign specific workouts and exercises based on the clients' goals and ambitions. We are expanding and creating 8 new suites to accommodate new technologies and our growing membership base.

Requirement

We require the supply, delivery, stacking and installation of 2 x 40ft high cube containers, these must be in good condition and watertight, along with supply and installation of a weatherproof staircase to provide access to 3 separate doors on the above container.

We require a full conversion of these containers including creation of 6 doorways and supply/installation of security doors and door furniture (handles, hinges, locks).

The containers will require insulation, ventilation along with framing (including ceiling) to separate them into 6 individual rooms (all 4m x 2.3m). We require a OSB3 skin on each wall to accommodate some heavy equipment that will require fixing along with soundproof plasterboard cover.

Quote should include

- 230 x 2.7m x 50mm C stud
- 90 x 3m x 52mm U Track
- 300m2 11m OSB3
- 38mm x 63mm x 2400mm CLS Stud
- 190m2 -Celotex Insulation (or equivalent)
- 60m 12.mm soundproof plasterboard
- 2 x internal solid wood walnut doors
- 9 x 1830m x 910m Acrylic Mirrors
- 8.5kw Electric shower
- 800mm x 800mm shower enclosure

Within our warehouse we require creation of an additional room using framing (metal or timber) and plasterboard (including a ceiling) 3m x 3m.

The separation of 2 existing rooms into 4 smaller rooms (2 new stud walls 4.5m x 3m), creation of 2 new doorways.

Plastering will be required on walls and ceilings 60m2 in total.









The successful supplier will be required to work alongside an electrician and plumber (these services not required).

Finishing will include painting, and the installation of wall murals* and mirrors.

Quotations should include supply of all materials and work, exc VAT.

*wallpaper murals will be supplied by Barerooms

Deliverable Timescale

We expect the project to commence approx. mid December 2022 and must be completed by 10th February 2023

Indicative Budget

£33,000 exc VAT

Evaluation Criteria

Quotations will be assessed and scored on the following criteria:

• Quality/ Technical Merit (50%)

Supplier must demonstrate they have the technical and professional capability to deliver the requirement.

• Delivery Timescale (20%)

Supplier must demonstrate they can deliver the requirement to timescales above.

• Cost/Value for money (30%)

Does supplier offer value for money. This will not necessarily be the cheapest quote.

Scoring Methodology

4 Excellent	Proposal meets and in some places, exceeds the required standard
3 Good	Proposal meets required standard
2 Acceptable	Proposal meets the required standard in most respects, but is lacking or
