Upgrade and Refurbishment of Industrial Units and Offices

Background – The Industrial Units and Offices have been vacated for approximately 3 to 4 years. The are currently in a semi-derelict condition requiring various works to bring the properties into a usable facility.

Requirement – The scope of works include but not limited to – re-cladding of the complete building plus roof repairs – total re-wire with heating and lighting upgrades – removal of existing boilers and obsolete radiators – upgrade of kitchen and toilet facilities – plaster boarding and skimming throughout – installation of ceiling grid and tiles throughout – painting and decorating – new windows and doors – upgrade of tarmac surrounds – new shutters and main gate entrance

Deliverable Timescale

We expect the project to commence no later than April 2023, and to be completed by July 2023
